



Basic Combat Rifle Crs (3-day)

Prerequisites: Open to Law Enforcement and Military ONLY. Students must provide proof of Police employment or Military membership at time of registration.

Description: This course prepares current patrol officers, or future SWAT officers, in the skill sets needed to safely, effectively and efficiently manipulate a rifle in a law enforcement/tactical encounter.

This course of instruction will give the patrol officer a thorough understanding of nomenclature, operations, disassembly and assembly skills, as well as marksmanship fundamentals; along with the care, cleaning and feeding of the urban rifle. The officer will come away from the course with a thorough understanding of shooting on the move, firing in dim light and being able to utilize other tactical equipment while maintaining control of the police rifle. This patrol rifle course focuses on short and mid-range applications of the rifle that can be applied immediately upon completion of the course while integrating the application of the force continuum into all tactics and techniques.

- Water Carrier: canteen, Camelbak, etc.
- Minimum of (3) rifle magazines
- Duty tactical weapon
 - *Handgun - 200 rounds
 - *Rifle - 800 rounds
- Individual issue tactical equipment. As a minimum:
 - Mag pouch platform (MOLLE type OTV gear)
 - Elbow/knee pads, gloves
 - Clothing suitable for outdoor tactical training

- Handheld flashlight (light source used on patrol)
