



Combat Life Saver (3-day)

Prerequisites: Open to Law Enforcement and Military ONLY. Students must provide proof of Police employment or Military membership at time of registration.

Description: This three day course focuses on those skills necessary to train a combat lifesaver. Combat Lifesaver is a bridge between the self-aid/buddy-aid (first aid) training given all soldiers during basic training and the medical training given to the combat medic.

The student will be introduced to immediate care that can save a casualty's life, such as stopping severe bleeding, administering intravenous fluids to control shock, and performing needle chest decompression for a casualty with tension pneumothorax through classroom as well as, situational training and realistic, practical exercises. The student will learn to combine immediate resources and available manpower to minimize further injury or loss of life and resolve active medical situations where no other options are readily available.

Combat Lifesaver Course recognizes that battlefield constraints will limit the ability of trained medical personnel, including combat medics (Health Care Specialist MOS 91W, Special Forces Medic 18D), to provide immediate, far-forward care.

Class size is limited. Additional classes will be scheduled on a quarterly basis.

Course Topics Covered:

- Performing tactical combat casualty care
- Evaluating a casualty
- Opening and managing a casualty's airway
- Treating penetrating chest trauma and
- Decompressing a tension pneumothorax
- Controlling bleeding
- Initiating a saline lock and intravenous infusion
- Initiating a field medical card
- Requesting medical evacuation (medevac)
- Evacuating a casualty using a sked® or improvised litter

Equipment Needed:

- Body Armor
- Eye & Ear Protection
- Water Carrier: canteen, Camelbak, etc.
- Duty tactical weapon

- *Handgun
- *Shoulder-fired entry weapon (if available)
- Individual issue tactical equipment. As a minimum:
 - Light source
 - Elbow/knee pads, gloves
 - Clothing suitable for outdoor tactical training
 - Handheld flashlight (light source used on patrol)
 - Groin protection
 - Coveralls or equivalent for paint marker use
