



Close Quarter Marksmanship-I (4-day)

Prerequisites: Open to Law Enforcement and Military ONLY. Students must provide proof of Police employment or Military membership at time of registration.

Description: This four day course is designed to develop firearms skills necessary for winning the armed close quarter confrontation. During the course, the student will develop accuracy under conditions of induced stress which will carry over to actual combat application. The culmination of our marksmanship training is the combat (stress) fire event. This puts together all of a soldier's marksmanship skills and runs him through a course similar to what he would face in urban combat. It is designed to assess, refine, and improve combat marksmanship. This course goes beyond providing an understanding of technique; it provides the exercises and practice needed to develop skills that can be applied immediately upon completion of the course.

Course Topics Covered:

- Safety
- Reflexive firing training
- Target discrimination
- Shotgun application
- Automatic fire
- Shift / Failure to Stop Drills
- 5-25 yard Qualification/Critical Task Evaluation (CTE) drills
- Administrative loading/unloading
- Tactical/Speed reloading
- Grip & Draw to ready position
- Draw, Fire, Down & Scan, Re-holster sequence
- Clearing stoppages
- Cover/Concealment
- One hand shooting
- Flashlight/Handgun usage
- Low light combat shooting
- Multiple threat engagement
- Shooting platform

Equipment Needed:

- 10 dummy rounds (Neon Colored)

- Body Armor
- Eye & Ear Protection
- Water Carrier: canteen, Camelbak, etc.
- Duty tactical weapon
 - *Handgun - 300 rounds
 - *Shoulder-fired entry weapon (if available) - 200 rounds
- Strong arm holster w/retention device
- Minimal of 4 mags per weapon, mag pouches, and a method of carrying equipment
- Individual issue tactical equipment. As a minimum:
 - Light source
 - Elbow/knee pads, gloves
 - Clothing suitable for outdoor tactical training
 - Handheld flashlight (light source used on patrol)
 - Groin protection
 - Coveralls or equivalent for paint marker use
 - Knee pads
